I work as a mixed media artist, and artist film-maker, part of the experimental video art group Neuf. Since 2004 I have worked as an artist facilitator on a selection of projects for arts organisations in Cambridgeshire and in the East of England in schools, museums, libraries, art galleries, hospitals and a hospice. I am a founder member of Cambridge Curiosity and Imagination and devised and delivered the first year of their Artscapers programme in the emerging Eddington development which has evolved as a well-being programme taking school communities in to their outside spaces to create, explore and make art for well-being. Trained in multiple techniques, my practice has focused on art facilitation in schools with young people and teachers/TA's, in museums with adults with anxiety and depression that during Covid 19 took place online, and continuing NEUF video art performance projects. In addition, after recent training with the Royal School of Drawing, I am working on a graphic novel.

I try to find fresh, innovative and enabling approaches to working with creative processes and outcomes within education environments and outside of these. I have been involved in programmes, and been co-author on publications, that research the value and legacy of these types of interdisciplinary and person centred ways of working. Additionally, I am interested in supporting people to explore and play with ideas around contemporary arts practices including those that embrace ecology and sustainability.
